## **BUDGET RECOMMENDATION & ACTION PLAN**

Fiscal Year: November 1, 2025 - November 1, 2026

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Lone Star Aviary Club projects a **total income of \$26,400** from 44 members paying \$600 annual membership fees. To ensure financial strength and member empowerment, immediate and strategic actions are required.

#### **KEY FINANCIAL RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### A. Strengthen Income Collection

#### 1. Mandatory Membership Payment Compliance

 Send biweekly payment reminders via WhatsApp, email, and phone calls until full payment is received.

#### 2. Late Payment Penalty

- o Introduce a \$25 late fee for members who have not paid by January 31, 2026.
- o Clearly communicate this policy in advance to encourage early compliance.

### 3. Quarterly Financial Report

- o Publish transparent updates every 3 months showing dues collected, expenses, and remaining balance.
- o Transparency builds trust and motivates prompt payments.

#### **B. Expand Income Sources**

#### 1. Fundraising Events

- o Host a July 4th BBQ fundraiser targeting at least \$3,000 in revenue.
- o Consider raffle draws, auctions, or donation drives to support club projects.

#### 2. Sponsorships & Partnerships

- o Approach local businesses for event sponsorships or charity collaborations.
- o Display their logos on event materials in return for support.

#### 3. Affiliate Program

o Encourage members to refer new sponsors, donors, or business partners, reward active contributors with recognition or discounts on next year's dues.

#### MEMBER SUPPORT & EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVES

The club's success depends on members being **financially stable and productive**. To ensure all members are working and can meet obligations, the following measures are recommended:

#### A. Job Support & Empowerment

#### 1. Career Development Team

- Create a 5-member Career Support Committee tasked with helping unemployed members find work or start small businesses.
- o Offer resume help, job referrals, and mentorship.

#### 2. Quarterly "Work & Wealth" Seminars

- o Partner with community agencies, Home Depot, or local training centers to provide free certifications (HVAC, construction, tech, etc.).
- o Encourage members to develop **side hustles** that generate extra income.

#### 3. Internal Member Hiring

o Encourage **members to hire fellow Aviary members** first when job openings arise in their businesses.

#### B. Accountability & Engagement

#### 1. Quarterly Employment Check-ins

- o During every general meeting, confirm members' employment or business status.
- o Offer support or referrals to those seeking opportunities.

#### 2. Mentorship Program

o Pair senior professionals with younger or transitioning members to build stability and career growth.
